Treasurer's Report:

Year to Date envelope income of \$30,559 is \$20,589 more than last year at this time and \$11,468 over the year to date average going back to 2009. The amounts given for Community Table and OCWM were paid out and all other expenses were caught up also.

Memorial Fund Balance: \$6,576.80

Reserve Fund Balance: \$5,443.91

The financial reports were reviewed and accepted.

Worship:

 There will be worship on Maundy Thursday, April 14 at 7:00 P.M. Easter Sunday we will have Muffin Breakfast at 9:30 A.M. and worship at 10:30 A.M

Building and Grounds:

• There is a lot of debris in the parts of the yard that get mowed.

We need to get it cleaned up before the first mowing to save the edge on the mower blades. We will look into having university students come to help with that (as well as washing windows) as part of their community service requirement.

Pastor's Report:

• Mike Wolfe will preach the two Sundays that Pastor David is gone in May (May 9–22).

Old Business:

- After some discussion, it was decided that masking will be optional in the building.
- We discussed child care, if needed, for the NW Association Annual Meeting here April 23.
 Pastor David thought perhaps someone from First Cong might be able to do it if it's needed.
- The Spring Thrift and Bake Sale will be May 21.

New Business:

- The "Little Library" has been built by Cindy's husband and will be installed near the sign at the end of the driveway.
- Barb will get some dates to serve at the Community Table.
