# **Food for Thought**

Communion will be held on June 1 and we will take our offering for the Community Table. We will also have a potluck! We have some ham and beef left over, so bring something to go with.

We are still recording our worship service to view on Facebook, for those who feel safer at home or can't make it to worship. COVID, RSV, and the flu are still around in our community. Masks are always available at church if you would like to wear one. Flu shots are

still recommended this season! The COVID vacine is still available, along with the RSV vaccine. The CDC is recommending you get a second COVID shot after six months.

Please don't forget our homeless friends. Mike and his crew are out checking on the homeless to make sure they are okay. Please keep them

in your prayers. With federal funding being cut, there are very few options for the homeless. We have a collection box in the Gathering area for clothing, or else you can send a check to CVSM, PO Box 51, Eau Claire, WI 54702-0051. Here is a needs list from the Street Ministry: hooded sweatshirts, in larger sizes so that they can layer; sleeping bags and blankets; men's underwear—new is preferred in all sizes. Also, monetary gifts are very welcome. They purchase city bus passes to provide those that need transportation to work or appointments. Also if they need some items not donated, they have to purchase them.

Also, don't forget our Birthday Challenge. We are challenging you to make a donation in your birthday month corresponding to your age. The money will be put toward our next big repair project, which now is a new copier for the office. June birthdays, it's your turn, plus if anyone wants to give extra toward a new copier, now's a perfect time.

## **Financial Reports:**

As of April 30, 2025 Year to Date Income \$50,346.82 Year to Date Expenses \$54,077.29 Ahead (Behind) \$(\$3,730.47)

#### **Treasurer's Report:**

Year to date envelope income is \$9,700 less than last year at this point, but still more than the YTD average going back to 2009. Expenses included the quarterly insurance bill, HVAC maintenance, and fire suppression system inspection. OCWM and Community Table payments were caught up in April.

**Memorial Fund Balance:** \$6,586.08

**Reserve Fund Balance:** \$24,040.76

Financial reports were reviewed and accepted.

#### **Building and Grounds:**

- Our new cleaning person started last Friday.

- Pastor's office is ready to paint. The office furniture needs cleaning and the carpet vacuumed well before we put the office back together.
- We need to look into getting a new copier. Ours is working pretty well, but we were told it's quite old (for a copier) and parts for it may soon not be available.
- The coffee pot was dripping, but seems to have stopped for now.
   We'll keep an eye on it.
- Heating panel in the ladies' room seemed overly hot. Will keep an eye on that too.

#### Pastor's Report:

 Pastor Michael was not here for the meeting, but left a written report for us. There was a lengthy discussion of some of his suggestions.

#### **Old Business:**
